Willow Valley Protocols & Guidelines:

Booking your Tee Time:

- Call the pro shop to book your tee time 905-679-2703
- Book online at www.willowvalleygolf.com (it may take a day or two for the online system to activate, for now, you call to book).
- We will not be accepting walk-on golfers at this time (you must have a tee time)
- Payment will be managed in the pro shop 1 person at a time
- Arrive at the golf course no earlier than 15 minutes before your tee time
- Scorecards and pencils will not be available – please bring your own

Carts:

- Power carts will be available 1 rider per cart unless riders reside at the same address
- Pull carts will be available & sanitized after each use. Please bring your own if you have one, as supplies are limited
- Carts will be parked in a sanitization area
- Carts must be returned to the cart return area when finished your round
- We will not be handling any garbage; we ask that you put your garbage in the bins provided in the parking lot – please do your part to keep the course clean and tidy

Food and Beverage:

- The clubhouse and patio will be temporarily closed until further notice for dining
- Take-out food will be available
- Call the pro shop to place an order 905-679-2703

Restrooms:

- Clubhouse restrooms will be closed
- Course restrooms will be open, these are located at Holes #5, #10 & #14

Sanitization stations:

- Willow Valley will offer hand sanitization stations at each restroom and entrance to the pro shop

On Course:

- We have a no touch flag system in place
- There are no bunker rakes on the course
- No ball washers
- No garbage cans except at each restroom station and parking lot
- Do not touch your playing partners equipment or golf ball
- Always maintain a 6-foot distance at all times
- Marshals will be present on the course and enforcing all rules of play
